

The Zones of Regulation

Over the last 2 years we have been implementing the Zones of Regulation which is a programme designed to teach students how to develop self regulation and emotional control. In our rooms you may have seen large coloured circles of the zones on the walls similar to the image below.



Teachers work through specific lessons throughout the year. Supporting this programme in each classroom are 'sensory desks' which you will have seen tucked into corners in the classrooms. The sensory desks are for students to spend 5-10 minutes regulating their emotions, we have a number of sensory items in the desk to assist with this. Have a look next time you are in the classroom.
